



## UNTAMED S2E11: Migration

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### Discussion Questions

*These discussion questions are designed to be used as a resource that inspires conversation, critical thinking, and promotes a “big picture” understanding of topics covered in each episode. Questions may be answered individually, or out loud in a group setting. Key terms and vocabulary that will help educators and students engage in discussion include:*

***Migration; habitat; habitat fragmentation; human development***

*The following questions are best used when paired with a complete viewing of the full episode, and may be more suitable for advanced levels:*

1. What are some of the reasons that animals might migrate?
2. Why is it valuable to track and record migrating animals' numbers?
3. Animals often cross international lines when they're migrating. Who's responsibility should it be to make sure they're kept safe?
4. While there are some things that are out of our control, there are also things we can impact. What are some of the threats migrating animals face? How can you help animals who may be migrating through your area?
5. How does migration affect wildlife rehabilitation for those species?

*The following questions are best used when paired with a viewing of “Migration: In (About) Two Minutes”, a synopsis of the major themes and key topics covered in the full episode, that may be more suitable for younger audiences:*

1. Why do some animals migrate while others don't?
2. Why is tracking animals that migrate important?
3. What can you do to help migratory animals on their journey?
